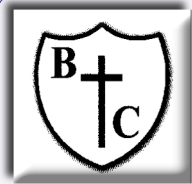
Basketball Jamboree

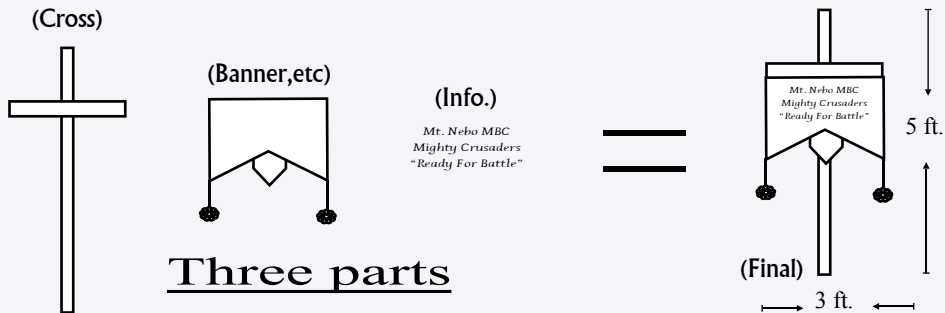
Host Church: Ebenezer Baptist Church, 1548 Dr. F. D. Reese Street. Selma, Alabama 36703
